The abstract shall be of the following format.

Format of Abstract and General Guidelines for Poster

Theme Area: Plastics for Sustainability

- Food / Water Preservation
- Renewable Energy Products
- Health and Shelter
- Environmental Protection

The abstract shall be of the following format:

- Category (student/academic/industrial)
- Title of the poster
- Authors/ affiliation (presenting author to be underlined)
- Category of the presenting author (student/scientist/faculty)
- Brief of material and experimentation
- Findings
- Application potential

The general Guidelines for poster participation are as follows:

For Student Category

- Material of investigation has to be polymer oriented
- Work should be based on *the research activity* and shall belong to the presenter himself/ herself
- Student certificate from the employer is required
- A few best posters in the *student's category* will be awarded

For Institute Category

- Material of investigation has to be polymer oriented
- Work should be based on the current *research activity* of the institute
- Presenter should be identified by the institute and should be one of the authors of the poster
- Category of the presenting author (student/scientist/faculty, to be underlined)

For Industries

- Material of investigation has to be polymer oriented
- Work may be the ongoing activity of the company
- Company may submit abstract based on the product development/machine development/ process development

The abstract should be submitted by 10th December, 2011 and the selected abstracts for the poster presentation will be intimated by 20th December, 2011. The actual poster presentation shall be submitted in PDF format by 10th January, 2012.
